- the importance of gender-sensitive leadership,
- and the opportunity to use digital tools for more accessible learning.

Through this training in Riga, Latvia, participants will:

- ✓ gain new competences in health & safety education,
- ✓ explore innovative digital learning methods,
- ✓ share experiences with European peers,
- ✓ and co-create ideas for more inclusive adult education.

The project's ultimate goal is to empower educators and community leaders to create safer, more inclusive, and future-ready learning environments across Europe.



What to Expect from Activities

The training is hands-on, interactive, and built around daily themes that help you grow step by step:

- Safety & Leadership Understand gender-specific risks and inclusive leadership.
- Best Practices Learn from European case studies and training centres.
- Digital Tools Create online modules and try interactive platforms.
- Peer Exchange & Collaboration Share experiences and co-develop training ideas.
- Inclusive Learning Address unconscious bias and design safe learning spaces.
- Community Engagement Visit municipalities and NGOs working on health & safety.
- Program Development Build and present pilot training programs.
- Future Planning Network, reflect, and celebrate with Europass Mobility recognition.

Expect a mix of workshops, study visits, group work, and reflections – all designed to give you practical tools for your work and community.



Tasks of Participants

Before the training, participants are expected to read the infopack, reflect on their own experiences in leadership, safety and education, and come prepared to share examples from their work or community. During the training, they will take an active role in workshops, study visits, and group work, contribute ideas in peer-to-peer sessions, and collaborate on developing and presenting a pilot training program. After the training, participants are encouraged to bring the new knowledge back to their organizations, share results with their communities, and apply the tools and methods in practice.

ACCOMODATION

Travel costs will be reimbursed within 3 months after the project, provided you:


- ✓ actively participate in the training

Our team will assist you in buying your tickets (if needed) and guide you on using the most suitable local transportation to reach your accomodation in Riga.




WHAT TO BRING


